# YOUR HEALTH RIGHTS:

## Access

- Health services and treatment that meets your or your mob's needs.

## Safety

- Culturally safe and high-quality care.

## Respect

- Be treated with respect, listened to, and have your culture, beliefs and choices respected.

## Information

- Clear information about your condition, and any benefits or risks of tests and treatments.
- Information about services, waiting times and costs.
- Assistance to help you understand and use health information, when you need it.
- Access your health information.
- Full details about anything that has gone wrong during your healthcare.

## Partnership

- Ask questions and make decisions with your health care provider.
- Include your mob, or anyone else in planning and decision-making.

## Privacy

- Have your personal privacy respected and your information kept confidential.

## Give Feedback

- Provide feedback or make a complaint.
- Have your concerns addressed.
